- ◆ **International Self-Care Day - July 24**
 - First celebrated in 2011 by the International Self-Care Foundation (UK) as a day to focus on doing the things that help your mental, physical and spiritual health.
- ◆ **World Tofu Day - July 26**
 - Created in 2014 by the Society for the Protection of Animals (SPA) to promote an alternative to meat consumption and move towards their goal to end animal cruelty.
- ◆ **Korean War Veterans Day - July 27**
 - Formally recognized in Canada in 2010 to honour Canadian military who served during the Korean conflict (1950-1953). The war officially ended on July 27, 1953 with the signing of an armistice.
