- Integrative health aims for well-coordinated care among different providers and institutions by bringing conventional and complementary approaches together to care for the whole person. First celebrated in 2009.

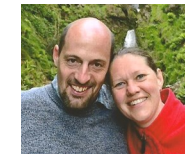
◆ **International Day of Education (UN)** - January 24
